A Message from the Parish Priest

Dear Parish Family,

Over the past year, St Ann's has witnessed remarkable growth. Our parish community has **increased by more than 230%**. New families, young people, children, and seniors have joined us. Our church is alive with faith, prayer, and activity.

With growth comes responsibility. Our current hall has served us faithfully for 60+ years. However, it now faces **clear limitations: restricted capacity, ageing wiring, insufficient heating, limited storage, and facilities that no longer fully support** the needs of our expanding parish.

After careful reflection and prayer, and through the generosity of a benevolent and long-standing parish donor who has pledged £300,000, we have begun exploring **the renovation and extension of our parish hall, together with a proper kitchen, sacristy, and an altar servers' room.**

This project is not merely about a building. It is about strengthening the pastoral heart of St Ann's for generations to come. We proceed with prudence, transparency, and in full consultation with the Diocese. **A Core Committee has been formed to guide this journey with accountability, unity, and faith.**

Please continue to pray for wisdom and harmony as we take these important steps together.

Improved safeguarding arrangements, appropriate privacy for altar servers, accessible facilities, and thoughtful circulation throughout.


A Hall that Sustains

What Is Being Considered



At this exploratory stage, the following are under consideration:

- A hall with seating capacity for approximately 120 people
- A light parish kitchen (not a commercial catering kitchen) suitable for hospitality and parish events
- Toilets in line with regulations and hall capacity
- A new sacristy with built-in cupboards for vestments and clerical items
- An altar servers' room ensuring privacy and safeguarding
- A possible meeting or conference room
- Conversion of the current sacristy into accessible overflow seating
- Adequate storage space for hall furniture
- Preservation of existing car park space

All elements remain subject to diocesan approval, architectural assessment, and planning permission.


This project belongs to the whole parish family.
